### *New York Area*

*A New York Area member is one whose residence or principal place of business is within 50 miles of City Hall in the Borough of Manhattan, City of New York.*

### *Washington, DC, Area*

40 and Over	\$2,880	\$645

*A Washington, DC, Area member is one whose residence or principal place of business is within 50 miles of the Capitol in the District of Columbia.*

### *National/International*

Age	Business	Non Business
Under 40	\$945	\$230
40 and Over	\$1,830	\$415

### **Per Council By-Law III:**

**Non-Business** members are those who are “regular members of the faculty of any accredited educational institution, who are in the public service, who are on the staff of a voluntary organization, or who are accredited writers, commentators, journalists, or other media correspondents.”

**Business** members are “all other members, except for honorary members.”

### **General Dues Information:**

Annual dues are billed in July, the first month of the Council on Foreign Relations (CFR) fiscal year. All dues should be paid annually or semiannually in equal installments. Annual dues cover goods and services provided by CFR, including a year’s subscription to *Foreign Affairs* valued at \$39.96; they are NOT tax-deductible as a charitable contribution. By-Laws provide suspension of privileges of a member in default for more than 60 days.
