RACHEL BRONSON

Rachel Bronson is a senior fellow and director of Middle East Studies at the Council on Foreign Relations where she has recently concluded work on her forthcoming book *Thicker than Oil: America's Uneasy Partnership with Saudi Arabia* (Oxford University Press, April 2006). She co-directed the January 2003 report *Guiding Principles for U.S. Post-Conflict Policy in Iraq*, co-sponsored by CFR and the James A. Baker III Institute for Public Policy at Rice University. She has testified before the Congressional Anti-Terrorist Finance Task Force, Congress' Joint Economic Committee on the topic of Iraq's reconstruction, and the President's 9_11 Commission on whether or not the U.S. is involved in a "Clash of Civilizations."

Dr. Bronson is the recipient of the Carnegie Corporation's 2003 Carnegie Scholars award. She has served as a consultant to the Center for Naval Analyses, as a Senior Fellow at the Center for Strategic and International Studies in Washington, DC, and as a Fellow at Harvard's Center for Science and International Affairs. Her writing has appeared in publications such as *Foreign Affairs*, the *Washington Quarterly*, the *National Interest*, *Survival*, the *New York Times* and the *International Herald Tribune*. She has commented extensively in the media including The Jim Lehrer News Hour, CNN, NBC, BBC, NPR, *Washingtonpost.com*, The Charlie Rose Show, al-Jazeera and appeared on the Daily Show with Jon Stewart. She received her doctorate from Columbia University in Political Science in 1997.
