Marc Levinson

Marc Levinson is senior fellow for international business at the Council on Foreign Relations (CFR).

For the past ten years, Mr. Levinson had been an economist at JP Morgan Chase & Co, where he advised investors on equity and credit implications of economic, regulatory, and market-structure changes and developed the company's environmental research effort.

He was previously the finance and economics editor at the *Economist* in London, senior writer for economics and business at *Newsweek*, and editorial director of the *Journal of Commerce*. Levinson has written extensively on trade policy, environmental affairs, finance, and logistics. He was coauthor of the CFR Book *After Reagan: Confronting the Changed World Economy*, published in 1988. His most recent book is *The Box: How the Shipping Container Made the World Smaller and the World Economy Bigger*, published in 2006.

Mr. Levinson has a BA from Antioch College, master's degrees from Georgia State University and Princeton University, and a PhD in history from the City University of New York.
