JEFF NEWELL

Colonel Jeff Newell is a military fellow at the Council on Foreign Relations. A command pilot in the U.S. Air Force with more than 3,500 flying hours, primarily in the C-130, he was the commander of the 12th Operations Group, 12th Flying Training Wing, Randolph Air Force Base, Texas, where he was responsible for directing AETC's Pilot Instructor Training, Combat Officer (Navigator) Training, and the USAF Advanced Instrument School. Prior to taking command of the 12th Operations Group, Newell served as the Air Force aide to President George W. Bush, and was responsible for carrying the President's emergency satchel and executing emergency plans for the protection of the President. He has extensive flying experience in Air Mobility Command and Air Force Special Operations Command, as well staff assignments on the air staff at the Pentagon.

Newell is a graduate of the Squadron Officer School, Army Command and Staff College, and the Air War College. He holds an MA in international relations from Troy State University, an MA from the School of Advanced Air and Space Power Studies, and a BS in Aerospace Engineering from the Georgia Institute of Technology.
