Daniel Senior

Daniel Senior, an expert on Iraq, Israeli-Palestinian relations, and Middle East and Persian Gulf geopolitics, security, and economics, is adjunct senior fellow for Middle Eastern studies at the Council on Foreign Relations (CFR). Senior is an analyst for Fox News and a founding partner of Rosemont Capital. He is currently working on a book about the Israeli economy and globalization in the Middle East (which will be published by TwelveBooks in 2009).

From 2003 to 2004, Senior served in the Administration of George W. Bush, as a Pentagon and White House advisor based in Doha, Qatar at U.S. Central Command Forward, and later based in Kuwait and Iraq, where he worked for both the Office of Reconstruction and Humanitarian Assistance (ORHA) and the Coalition Provisional Authority (CPA). He was chief spokesman and senior advisor for the Coalition. One of the longest serving civilians in Iraq, Senior was awarded the Department of Defense Distinguished Civilian Service Award. Previously, Senior was a foreign policy and communications advisor in the U.S. Senate. He writes frequently for the *Wall Street Journal* and has also authored pieces for the *New York Times*, the *Washington Post*, the *New York Post*, and *The Weekly Standard*.

Senior completed his undergraduate studies at the University of Western Ontario and studied at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. He later attended Harvard Business School, where he completed his MBA.
