## Scott A. Snyder

Scott Snyder is adjunct senior fellow for Korea studies at the Council on Foreign Relations (CFR).

Mr. Snyder is senior associate in the international relations program of The Asia Foundation and Pacific Forum CSIS, and is based in Washington, DC. He lived in Seoul, South Korea as Korea Representative of The Asia Foundation during from 2000 to 2004.

Previously, he served as a Program officer in the research and studies program of the U.S. Institute of Peace, and as acting director of The Asia Society's contemporary affairs program. His latest monograph *China's Rise and the Two Koreas: Economics, Politics, Security* will be published by Lynne Rienner in 2009. His publications include *Paved with Good Intentions: The NGO Experience in North Korea* (2003), co-edited with L. Gordon Flake and *Negotiating on the Edge: North Korean Negotiating Behavior* (1999).

Mr. Snyder received a BA from Rice University and an MA from the Regional Studies East Asia Program at Harvard University. He was the recipient of a Pantech visiting fellowship at Stanford University's Shorenstein Asia-Pacific Research Center (2005-2006), received an Abe fellowship, administered by the Social Sciences Research Council (1998-99), and was a Thomas G. Watson fellow at Yonsei University in South Korea (1987-1988).
