Paul B. Stares

Paul B. Stares is the General John W. Vessey senior fellow for conflict prevention and director of the Center for Preventive Action at the Council on Foreign Relations (CFR). Prior to joining CFR, Dr. Stares was the vice president and director of the Center for Conflict Analysis and Prevention at the U.S. Institute of Peace. In that capacity he also chaired the Iraq Study Group's Strategic Environment Expert Working Group.

In addition to directing CFR's conflict prevention work, Dr. Stares is currently leading an expert working group on preventive diplomacy for the Genocide Prevention Task Force (a joint initiative of the U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum, American Academy of Diplomacy, and U.S. Institute of Peace) that is co-chaired by Madeleine Albright and William Cohen. He is also a member of the East-West Institute's International Task Force on preventive diplomacy.

Dr. Stares worked as an associate director and senior research scholar at Stanford University's Center for International Security and Cooperation (2000-02); senior research fellow, Japan Institute of International Affairs, and director of studies, Japan Center for International Exchange (1996-2000); senior fellow and research associate, Foreign Policy Studies Program, Brookings Institution (1984-1996); and NATO fellow; scholar-in-residence, MacArthur Foundation–Moscow Office.

Dr. Stares is the author of numerous books and articles, including: *Rethinking the 'War on Terror': New Approaches to Conflict Prevention and Management in the Post-9/11 World* (U.S. Institute of Peace, 2007); *Rethinking Energy Security in East Asia* (Japan Center for International Exchange, 2000), *The New Security Agenda: A Global Survey* (Japan Center for International Exchange, 1998), *Global Habit: The Drug Problem in a Borderless World* (Brookings Institution, 1996).
