Micah Zenko

Micah Zenko is a fellow for conflict prevention in the Center for Preventive Action at the Council on Foreign Relations. Previously, he worked for five years at Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government in a number of research positions, and in Washington, DC, at the Brookings Institution, Congressional Research Service, Wisconsin Project on Nuclear Arms Control, Veterans for America, and State Department's Office of Policy Planning, where he was a contributor to the Department's Kosovo History Project.

He has also published on a range of national security issues, including op-eds in the *Washington Post*, *Los Angeles Times*, *Chicago Tribune*, and *Boston Globe*, and articles in *Parameters*, *Defense and Security Analysis*, *Annals of the American Academy of Political and Social Science*, and the *Journal of Strategic Studies*.

Dr. Zenko received a PhD in political science from Brandeis University, where he completed a policy-evaluative dissertation on U.S. uses of limited military force in the post-Cold War world.
