

**Chris Canavan**

Chris Canavan is a partner at Lion's Head Global Partners and runs the firm's New York office. Prior to joining Lion's Head, he was director of global policy development for George Soros. He also spent more than a decade at Goldman Sachs, where he was chief risk officer of Goldman's commercial bank, ran a credit trading desk in the commodities business, headed the Latin America debt capital markets team, and was responsible for managing the firm's Latin America sovereign and credit risk. Prior to joining Goldman, he taught economics at Boston College and Columbia University.
