Sunjoy Joshi is chairman of the Observer Research Foundation (ORF). He began his career with the government in India as a member of the Indian Administrative Service in 1983, serving in various capacities for twenty-five years. His last posting with the government of India was as joint secretary in the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural gas. He joined ORF to pursue his primary interests in energy and the environment. He has previously been director of the board of national energy companies such as the Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC), ONGC Videsh Limited, and Oil India Limited, Mangalore Refinery and Petrochemicals Limited, and has wide experience in administering fiscal and contractual regimes for oil and gas.
